QUICK SAFETY TIPS OKLAHOMA STORM SEASON GUIDE

Before the Storm

- Label your breaker panel for quick shutoff.
- Check breakers for looseness, rust, or corrosion.
- **Install or test a whole-home surge protector.**
- Unplug sensitive electronics before storms.
- Cover outdoor outlets with weatherproof covers.
- Look for branches near service lines — call utility if needed.
- Test your generator and store fuel safely (never indoors).

After the Storm

- Stay clear of downed or sagging power lines — call the utility.
- Do not enter wet or flooded areas with wiring or outlets.
- Inspect your breaker panel for tripped breakers; reset only if dry and safe.
- Watch for sparks, smoke, or burning smells near panels/outlets.
- Check your outside meter — if blank/error, call your power company.
- Use surge protection when reconnecting electronics.

⚠ Safety Check

Stop and call us immediately if you notice:

- Breakers tripping repeatedly
- Water damage near panels or outlets
- Buzzing or humming in your panel
- Flickering/dimming lights during normal use
